

Uganda Talks Newspaper Round Up



Forum for Democratic Change candidate Jack Wamanga Wamai was last night declared the [new](#) Mbale Municipality MP after humiliating six other candidates in a contest punctuated by gunshots.

The Member of Parliament for Rubanda West, Mr Henry Banyenzaki, is lobbying fellow legislators to [block](#) the approval of the Shs286 billion supplementary budget being requested by the government.

The curious absence of Ugandan lawmakers at yesterday's sitting of the East African Legislative Assembly forced House Speaker Abdirahin Abdi to prematurely adjourn business due to lack of quorum because the Ugandan MPs were bickering over [juicy](#) posts on influential committees at the regional parliament.
