Uganda Electricity Generation Company Limited (UEGCL) has the mandate to develop, acquire, operate, and maintain electricity generation facilities in Uganda. UEGCL is the government's implementing agency for the 600MW Karuma Hydropower Project and the 6.6MW Nyagak III Hydropower Project in Zombo District.

UEGCL has built internal capacity to operate and maintain electricity generation facilities in Uganda. UEGCL commenced operations and maintenance of the 183MW Isimba Hydropower Plant in 2019, and subsequently took over the 50 MW Namanve Thermal Plant in 2022. After a 20-year Concession period, UEGCL repossessed the operations and maintenance of the 380MW Nalubaale-Kiira power plants, which continues to show progress in empowerment of Ugandans under the NRM Manifesto.

UEGCL will continue with plans to undertake other projects like the 48MW Muzizi Hydropower Project, the rehabilitation of the 1MW Maziba Hydropower Station, and the floating solar projects.

We appreciate the support of the NRM Government towards UEGCL during the implementation of the Community Development Action Plans for both Karuma and Isimba Hydropower Projects.

UEGCL is fully committed to its purpose of making electricity safely available for supply at all times from all its power-generating plants.
